### **Service Evaluation**

- Examine data and plan future Dual Diagnosis work in light of results

### **Dual Diagnosis Statement Of Purpose**

- Working with commissioners from Clinical Commissioning Groups and Adult Social Care to develop a dual diagnosis strategy/framework for Leeds

### **Level 2 training evaluation**

- Undertake robust evaluation of effectiveness of training in practice

### **Expert Reference Group**

- Continue to support the development of the group and build upon their work to date

## **Primary Care Mental Health**

- Identify and implement an effective treatment pathway for substance misusers with common mental health problems

## **LYPFT**

- Continue to work with and support LYPFT with dual diagnosis issues through Transformation

- Support to ensure that dual diagnosis is recognised and accounted for in any recommissioning that might take place
